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AnMed Health purchases a state-of-the-art training tool for medical education program

(Anderson, S.C. - September 3, 2019) - The AnMed Health Auxiliary has provided funding for the purchase of Bob, a state-of-the-art training tool, for AnMed Health's medical education program. The educational simulator helps students learn how to diagnose ailments in the heart, lungs and abdomen using ultrasound.

“We are so happy to provide this state-of-the-art educational module for our students, residents, physicians and staff. We are only the second site in South Carolina to have this important teaching tool,” said Dr. Stoney Abercrombie, campus dean for the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC) and director of medical education at AnMed Health.

Dr. Brian Mulroy, AnMed Health's site director for Family Medicine added, “With the state-of-the-art manikin-based system, students receive real-life experience in diagnosing common ailments with ultrasound.”
