## Remembering AnMed Health and community leader

*(Anderson, S.C. – Apr 9, 2018)* – The AnMed Health family is deeply saddened by the passing of Kirk Oglesby.

During his 30 years as AnMed Health’s president and CEO, the organization changed dramatically evolving well beyond a community hospital to the beginnings of a major healthcare system. Mr. Oglesby possessed extraordinary leadership abilities and unquestionable integrity. He is remembered as a visionary who set goals and achieved them, a man of great honesty and conviction.

“When I reflect on my good fortune to have observed Mr. Oglesby’s leadership and enjoy his mentorship, I think about “integrity,” said Bill Manson, current President and CEO, AnMed Health. “Whether it was his personal commitment to his spouse, Bobbie, his family, his church, or any of the hundreds of organizations that benefitted from his leadership, everyone that was exposed to him knew that he was a person of integrity in every sense of the word.”

Mr. Oglesby was the only individual ever to serve as chairman of all three of the nation’s most prominent healthcare organizations (American College of Healthcare Executives, 1986; American Hospital Association, 1992; and Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations, 1993), and was recognized nationally for his many contributions to the industry.

Manson said, “I consider myself extremely fortunate to have witnessed his incredible career and to be able to call him a mentor, supporter and friend.”

We as a health system and as a community were extremely fortunate to benefit from the vision, leadership and community advocacy of Mr. Oglesby. He will be missed.
