WHAT: AnMed Health one of six South Carolina landmarks to light up for Metastatic Breast Cancer Awareness Day

WHEN: Tuesday, October 13, 2020

TIME: 8 p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST)

WHERE: Front Entrances of AnMed Health Cancer Center, 2000 East Greenville Street, Anderson, S.C. and AnMed Health Medical Center, 800 N. Fant Street, S.C.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. AnMed Health has been acknowledging the month by lighting up the front entrances of the Medical Center and Cancer Center with pink lights at night.

On Tuesday, Oct. 13, AnMed Health will change the pink lights to teal to participate in the #LightUpMBC event. It is an event marking Metastatic Breast Cancer (MBC) Awareness Day. AnMed Health is one of six landmarks in South Carolina and one of 115 sites in the United States lighting up as part of the #LightUpMBC campaign to raise awareness of the deadly disease. Metastatic Breast Cancer is stage 4 cancer that has spread outside of the breast to other organs such as bones, liver, lung or brain.
