Family Medicine Center

1. Independently evaluate (not just shadow) at least 4 patients per half-day session.
2. Documenting a SOAP note for each the 4 patients you independently evaluate.
3. Present 2 cases to the preceptor per half-day session.
4. Complete 2 full SOAP notes per half-day session to review with the provider

ATS (Adult Inpatient)

1. Carry a census of at least 4 patients.
2. Admit at least 2 patients per call day.
3. Present at least 2 patients per rounding session
4. Present one medical topic during rounds weekly.
